TAHQUITZ LOYALTY RESERVATION

Troops that are currently attending camp may make a reservation for the same session next year. Loyalty Reservations must be made prior to check out from camp during the current year and must include a \$ 200.00 non-refundable deposit.

GENERAL RESERVATIONS:

General Reservations will be made on a first-come, first serve basis following the close of the current camping season.

CAMPSITE SELECTION

Our primary goal is to ensure the successful utilization of the camp and to provide the best camping experience for as many Scouts as possible.

To ensure efficient utilization, all campsites have **REQUIRED** minimums, and have a suggested maximum Scoutcapacity. You may **TENTATIVEL**Y select/reserve a specific campsite. However, if your attendance is below the site minimum, you may be moved to another campsite upon arrival for a more appropriate location based on your unit size, or another unit may be assigned to share your site with you.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

• First Payment Deposit is due upon submitting your application

A non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$200 is required with the completed application form. (It will be returned if no space is available). The deposit is applied to a troop's final payment, not to any specific individual.

Second Payment is due February 1st

An additional payment of \$100 times the total number of Scouts is due. For example if you have signed up 20 Scouts then \$2,000.00 is due.

• Third Payment is due May 1st

An additional payment of \$100 times the number of Scouts is due. In the same example as above: if you have 20 Scouts signed up then another \$ 2,000.00 is due.

Fourth Payment is due 14 days prior to arrival at camp

A late fee of \$ 30.00 will be added to your final bill payment if received less than 14 days prior to arrival at camp.

CANCELLATIONS

Each payment is based on the total number of Scouts and/or Leaders. If there are any reductions in total numbers (Scouts or adults) after each payment, there will be no refund of previous payments.

LEADERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with BSA policy, our camps require that at least two registered leaders must be in camp with your unit at all times. One must be at least 21, the other at least 18. Both must have current Youth Protection Training.

UNIT ACCIDENT INSURANCE IS REQUIRED FOR ATTENDANCE AT CAMP

Long Beach units are covered by the Council's policy. Out of Council units need to provide proof of insurance.
