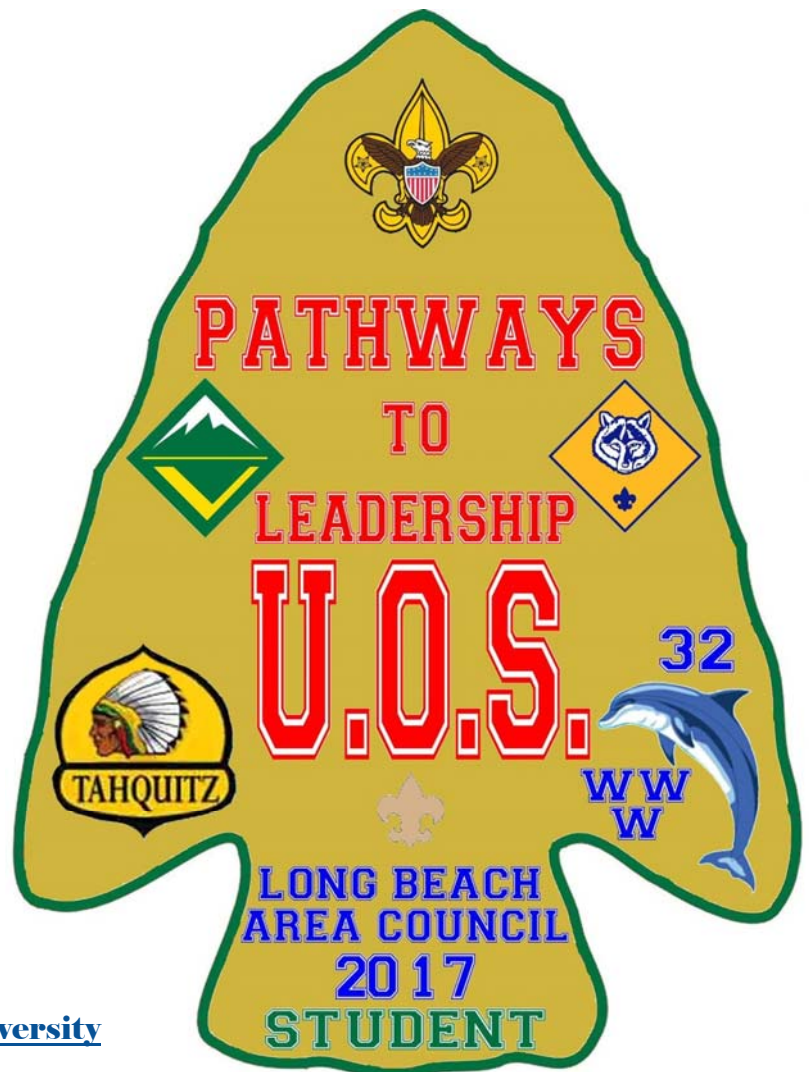

About the Event

The Long Beach Area Council Training Committee wishes to welcome you to the inaugural University of Scouting event! We hope you enjoy the day expanding your knowledge and networking with other Scouters.

What is it? UOS is a single day concentrated training event offering 50 courses in a classroom setting.

Courses are divided into “colleges” and participants can attend up to 6 classes and visit an Exhibitor Midway.

Who should go? You! UOS has something to offer leaders, volunteers and youth at every scouting level.

Why should I go? UOS takes your training to the next level and enhances your overall Scouting experience.

How do I register? Online registration is preferred at <https://longbeachbsa.camp-master.com>.

What is the deadline? Early registration (\$25) deadline is February 3; After Feb 3, registration is \$35.

What is included? Registration include classes, patch, CD-ROM of presentations, box lunch and goody bag.

Which courses do I pick? Adults can register for any classes in any “college”. We will do our best to accommodate your 1st choices if you register prior to Feb. 3. Walk-in class availability is subject to class sizes.

Where is it? The event is at Long Beach City College, Liberal Arts Campus, Building T.

Where do I park? Parking is available in the Parking Structure on Clark Avenue south of Carson Street.

Do I need to bring anything? A box lunch is included in the fee, and no other materials are needed.

Are there any prerequisites? No, however, some courses are designed for specific registered leaders.

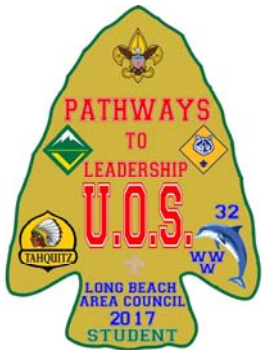
