



## Long Beach Sea Base BSA Weekend Aquatics Program Guidelines & Fees Sheet

- The Long Beach Sea Base is available to all registered Scouts, Scouters and members of their immediate families
- Facility Use Permit must be filed in Council Office a minimum of two weeks in advance of date requested
- A tour plan must be filed by all Scout Units for use of the Base
- Signed Parental Consent Forms and Adult Hold Harmless Agreements must be brought day of for all participants
- There will be A \$25.00 cancellation fee if event is cancelled, except for weather
- **Daytime Use** includes usage of equipment and beach from 9am-5pm Saturday and/or Sunday.
- The fee for daytime usage:

In-Council Unit	Out-of-Council Unit/Not-For-Profit
\$15/person/day with \$225 min.	\$20/person/day with \$300 min.

- A damage and cleaning deposit of \$300 is due at time of reservation
- Estimated fees and deposits must be paid in the Council Office before use of Base is permitted
- Current BSA Lifeguard(s) or equivalent, and/or BSA Aquatics Supervision: Swimming and Water Rescue at a ratio of 1 Lifeguard for every 25 participants- If the Unit does not have their own, a list of available BSA Lifeguards can be provided by the Dockmaster. The Unit pays the Lifeguard(s) directly at the Unit's expense
- Unit must always maintain a ratio of 1 adult for every 10 Boy Scout age youth and/or 1 adult for every 5 Cub Scout age youth
- A cold outdoor shower is available to wash off the sand from beach
- All equipment and PFD's must be properly rinsed with fresh water and put away and the facility areas clean or the Unit will forfeit their deposit
- The Base has BBQ's available for usage. Units can bring their own BBQ's.
- The Base does not have any food for sale day or night. Units are encouraged to bring their own.
- **The adult leader in charge must meet with the Dockmaster** prior to their date to go over what programs and equipment they will need while at the Base.
- **USE OF THE FACILITY AND EQUIPMENT IS AT THE UNIT'S OWN RISK**
- **PROPER SUPERVISION AND ADHERENCE TO BSA SAFE SWIM DEFENSE, BSA SAFETY AFLOAT, BSA SUPERVISION:PADDLECRAFT SAFETY & SWIMMING AND WATER RESCUE, AS WELL AS ALL OTHER APPLICABLE BSA NATIONAL POLICIES IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE UNIT**
